

Admission process to be online in DTU

NEW DELHI, 18 MAY: Admissions for the coming academic session in the Delhi Technical University (DTU) is going to be online for over 1200 seats. So, the students would not to run around and make a beeline even for the prospectus.

The DTU vice-chancellor, Prof P B Sharma said that the varsity has tied up with the National Informatics Centre (NIC) to create a website for the smooth exercise of admission. The university has also

decided to start a new course as mathematics and computing science from the forthcoming session with total number of 75 seats.

According to in-charge of admission committee, Prof O P Verma, the admission list will be out on the basis of merit list of All India Engineering Entrance Examination.

The students can download the challan from the website—www.dtuadmissions.nic.in between 7 June to 15 June. The students would then have to get a draft of Rs 1000 from the State

Bank of India. The registration process will start from 23 June and first merit list will be out by 6 July. If the seats are left vacant then a second list will be released.

There are now total 15 courses up for grabs in B.Tech courses such as electronics and communications, civil engineering, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering, polymer science and chemical technology, information technology, software technology, environmental engineering, automobile engineering, computer science, electrical and electronics.
