

DTU VC junks charges of teachers

New Delhi: Rubbishing the charges of financial and administrative irregularities leveled against him by teachers of Delhi Technological University (DTU), vice-chancellor PB Sharma alleged they were aimed at "demolishing the university".

Sharma said, "The teachers had incited the students against DTU last year on the pretext that DCE as DTU shall stand to lose its reputation resulting in poor job prospects for them."

On the issue of terms and conditions for continuation of teachers and employees of the erstwhile DCE, university sources said necessary action is being taken. Sharma said, "A committee, set up by the Delhi government to settle the service conditions of the staff employed with the erstwhile DCE and now working at DTU, is supposed to submit its report in six weeks."

As many as 114 teachers from the erstwhile Delhi College of Engineering (DCE) recently wrote to the Delhi government asking for a transfer to DTTE alleging that the DTU administration had failed to protect their interests.
