

Test for free coaching of civil services at Jamia

NEW DELHI, 25 JULY: The Centre for Coaching and Career Planning at Jamia Millia Islamia will conduct an entrance test on 11th September to provide free coaching for the SCs, STs and women aspirants of civil services.

Jamia will conduct written test of General Studies and CSAT (Civil Servant Aspirant Test), also essay writing. The Centre will be providing free coaching, library facilities and accommodation for aspirants. Last year 1,200 students appeared for the entrance test for 100 seats. The centre has the best professionals for various subjects and will provide classes for subjects like General Studies, CSAT and selected optional papers. Not only classes but also conduct test which are carried out by the faculty. Keeping in mind the changing nature of examination, the Centre is providing coaching for CSAT. The Academy will also conduct Mock Interviews for selected candidates in the Main examination.

IAS coaching at Jamia has been very effective. Last year 89 students cleared various competitive examinations and entrance tests. Recently the UGC granted Rs 15 crore for setting up Residential Coaching Academy in Jamia Millia Islamia. Till then the admitted students will be provided temporary accommodation in the vicinity of Jamia itself. **sns**
