Google offers DTU boy Rs 55L package

New Delhi, May 29

Delhi Technological University (DTU) has hit an impressive record in campus placement this year, with Google offering Rs 55 lakh annually to Priyanshu Jain, a fourth year student of the department of computer engineering. Besides, three students of the department

-- Ajay Behari Gupta, Gaurav Kumar and Saikat K. Debnath-have been offered Rs 40 lakh per annum by American software firm EPIC. Another student Debnath has got Rs 20-lakh offer from Google.

The companies that have visited DTU recently include Microsoft, Indian Oil, Maruti, TCS, Mckinsey, Oracle, NTPC, Wipro, Google, and Adobe, according to Neeraj Nimwal, placement officer, DTU.

"A highlight of this year's placement is that besides making job offers to final year students, companies are also offering paid internship to third year students. This will prepare students for the challenges of the industry," he added.
