NEW VALUE-ADDED SERVICE:

1. **Wiley 908 journals:** The Library has newly subscribed to Wiley 908 journals from January 2024.
2. **Grammarly:** A newly subscribed Grammarly is a cloud-based typing assistant. It reviews spelling, grammar, punctuation, clarity, engagement, and delivery mistakes in English texts, detects plagiarism, and suggests replacements for the identified errors. It also allows users to customize their style, tone, and context-specific language. Grammarly is available as a standalone application for use with desktop programs, a browser extension optimized for Google Docs, and a smartphone keyboard.
3. **Harvard Business Publishing:** Library has started to serve our students with Harvard Business Publishing cases.
4. **Web of Science:** The e-Shodh Sindhu has started access to Web of Science to DTU. Web of Science is an online subscription-based scientific citation indexing service originally produced by the Institute for Scientific Information, now maintained by Clarivate Analytics that provides a comprehensive citation search.
5. **RemoteXs:** - To provide remote access to electronic resources the Library has started the subscription to RemoteXs. It is a one stop solution to provide users a single window access to their digital resources.

6. **DELNET**: DELNET has been established promotes resource sharing among the libraries through the development of a network of libraries. It aims to collect, store, and disseminate information besides offering computerized services to users, to coordinate efforts for suitable collection development and also to reduce unnecessary duplication wherever possible.
7. **Economic & Political Weekly**: The Economic and Political Weekly is a weekly peer-reviewed academic journal covering all social sciences and is published by the Sameeksha Trust.
8. **Rare Book Collection**
The library has lots of rare books for which a separate collection has been made.
9. **DTU Publication Archive**
The library has also created an archive for publications published by faculty and research scholars of DTU
10. **Federated search – J-Gate**
To facilitate the library users, the library has access to J-GATE, a federated search engine. It serves as a single gateway for e-journals.
11. **Manuscript**
Digital Manuscript from Indira Gandhi National Centre for the Arts and Oriental Institute: The Maharaja Sayajirao University of Baroda has been purchased by the library.
12. **VRD**
The Central Library has good reference collection and provides reference service to the members. Library will answer brief reference questions for patrons via email. This service is intended for brief questions and requests for more complex reference questions cannot be replied.
13. **Digital Library of India**
Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) under its National Mission on Education through Information and Communication Technology (NMEICT) has initiated the National Digital Library of India (NDL India) pilot project to develop a framework of virtual repository of learning resources with a single-window search facility. Filtered and federated searching is employed to facilitate focused searching so that learners can find out the right resource with least effort and in minimum time.
14. **IRINS**
IRINS is web-based Research Information Management (RIM) service developed by the Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre in collaboration with the Central University of Punjab. The portal facilitates the academic, R&D organisations and faculty members, scientists to collect, curate and showcase the scholarly communication activities and provide an opportunity to create the scholarly network.
