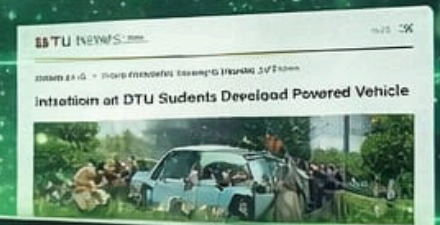
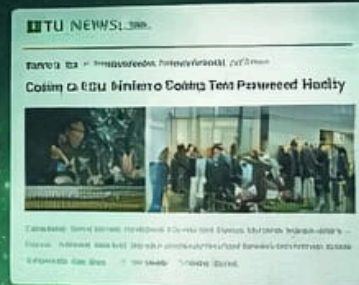


# NOVUS LITERA
