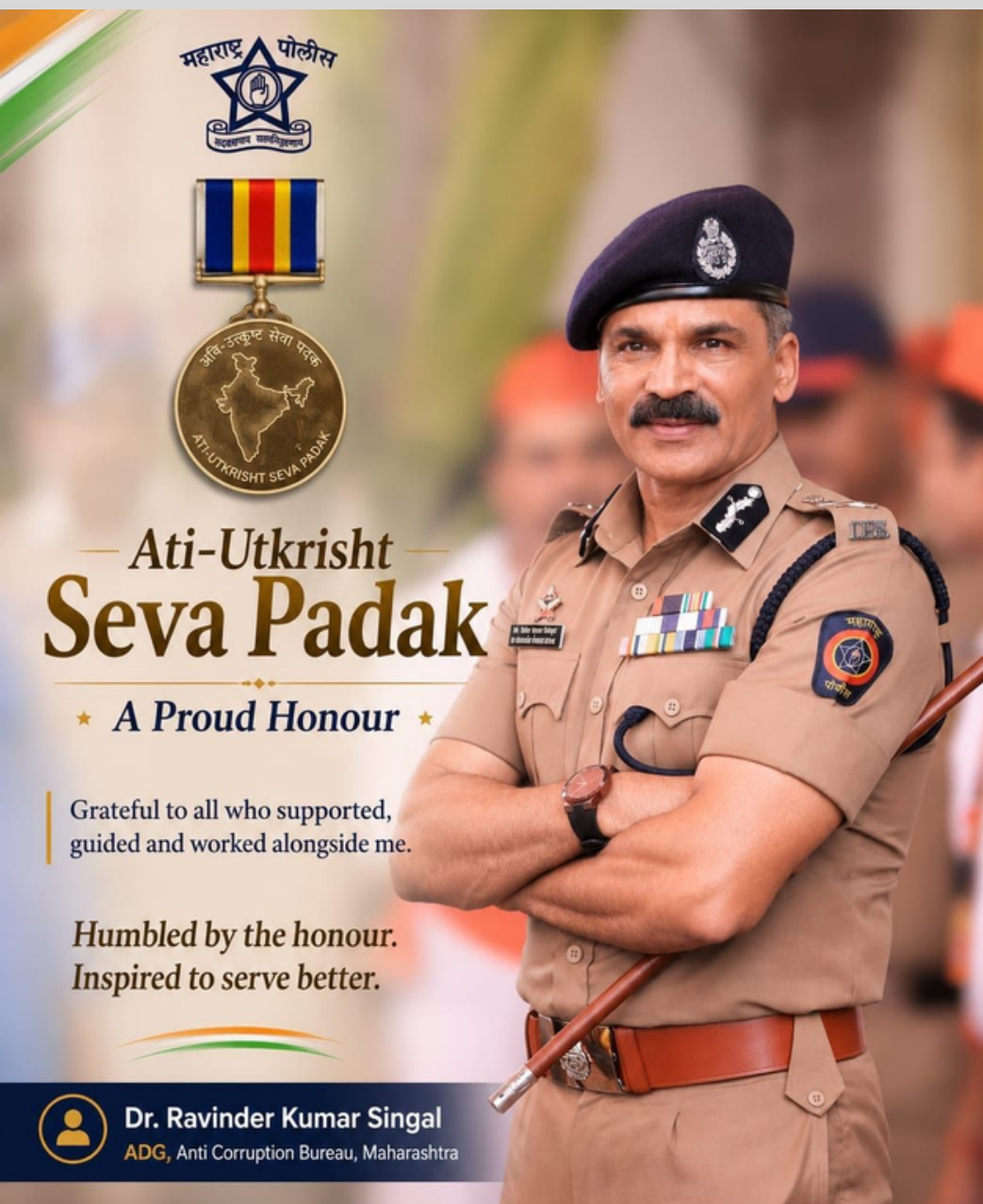

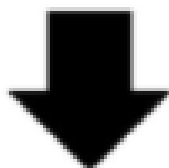
DTU East Delhi Campus Welcomes Batch of 2026 at USME Orientation
